Answers to FAQ

You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying Music for Africa.

Registering with the Music for Africa Gift Aid Scheme costs nothing.

Music for Africa will only use your name and address for the purpose of reclaiming the tax on donations.

If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.

We can only reclaim tax on donations made from a personal bank or building society account. We cannot claim Gift Aid on donations made from company accounts.

If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR 113 Gift Aid.
